

Piecing Instructions:

Chain Block Units:

Assemble one Fabric D rectangle and one Fabric B rectangle.
Unit should measure 3" x 13".



Crib:
Make 2 from each FQ (12 total).

Twin:
Make 2 from each FQ (24 total).

Lap:
Make 2 from each FQ (20 total).

King:
Make 2 from each FQ (64 total).

Assemble one Fabric B rectangle, one Fabric F rectangle and one Fabric I square.

Unit should measure 3" x 13".



Crib:
Make 2 from each FQ (12 total).

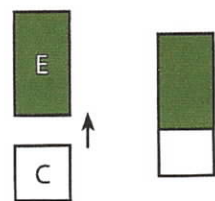
Twin:
Make 2 from each FQ (24 total).

Lap:
Make 2 from each FQ (20 total).

King:
Make 2 from each FQ (64 total).

Assemble one Fabric E rectangle and one Fabric C square.

Unit should measure 3" x 8".



Crib:
Make 2 from each FQ (12 total).

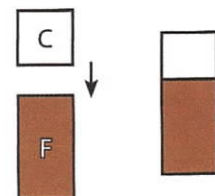
Twin:
Make 2 from each FQ (24 total).

Lap:
Make 2 from each FQ (20 total).

King:
Make 2 from each FQ (64 total).

Assemble one Fabric F rectangle and one Fabric C square.

Unit should measure 3" x 8".



Crib:
Make 2 from each FQ (12 total).

Twin:
Make 2 from each FQ (24 total).

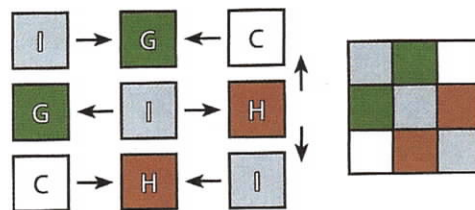
Lap:
Make 2 from each FQ (20 total).

King:
Make 2 from each FQ (64 total).

Assemble three Fabric I squares, two Fabric G squares, two Fabric H squares and two Fabric C squares.

Fabric G and Fabric H should be different fabrics.

Unit should measure 8" x 8".

Make 12.

Lap:
Make 20.

Twin:
Make 24.

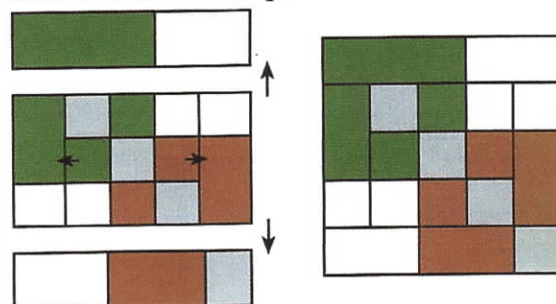
King:

Chain Block One:

Assemble Chain Block One.

Chain Block One should measure 13" x 13".

Pay close attention to unit placement.

Make 12.

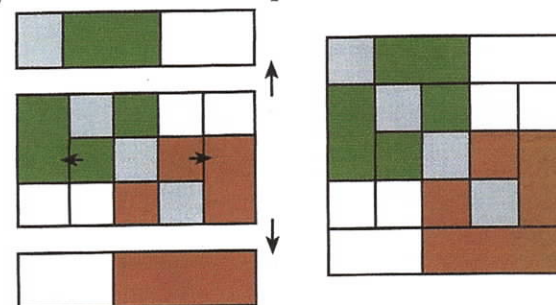
King:
